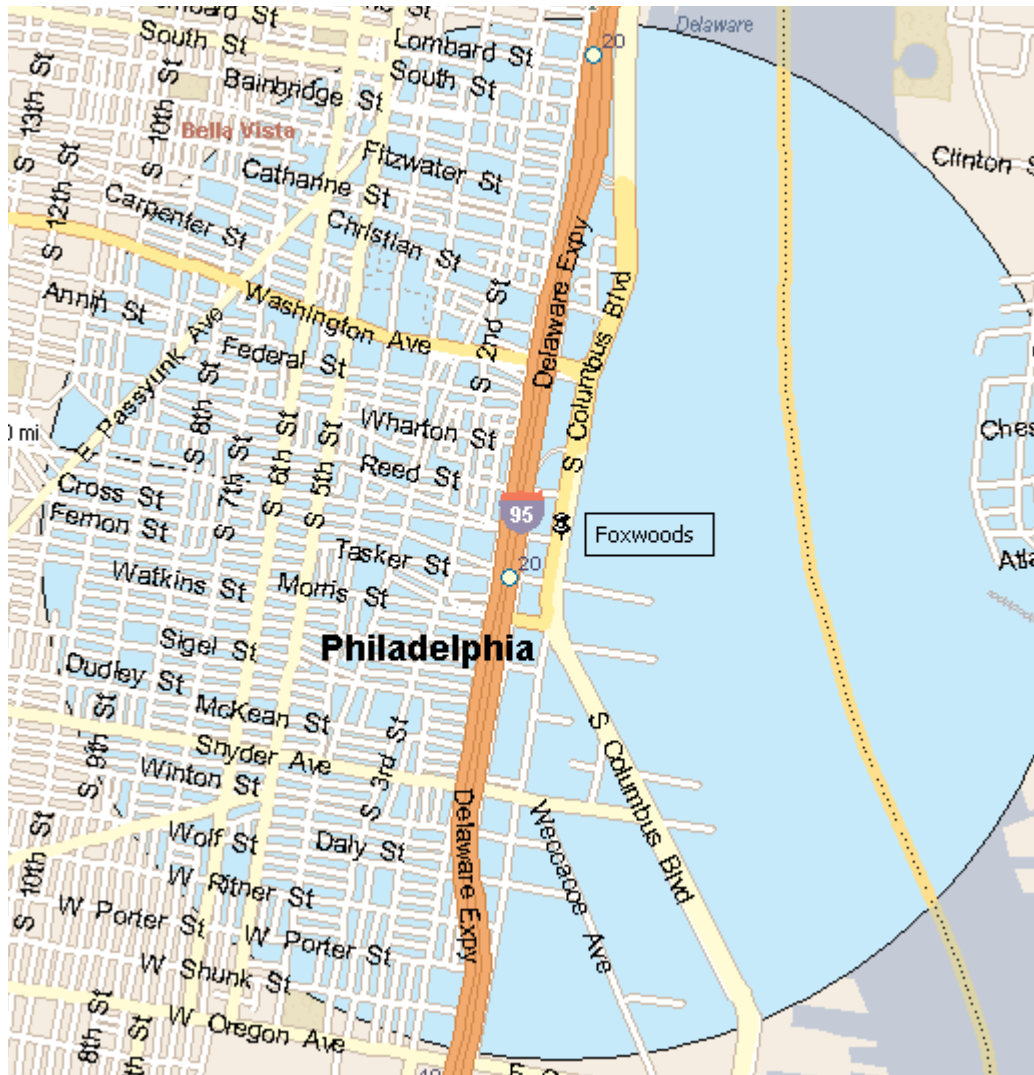

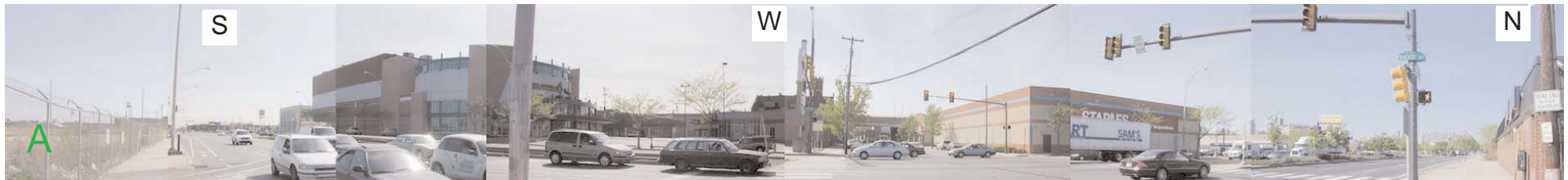

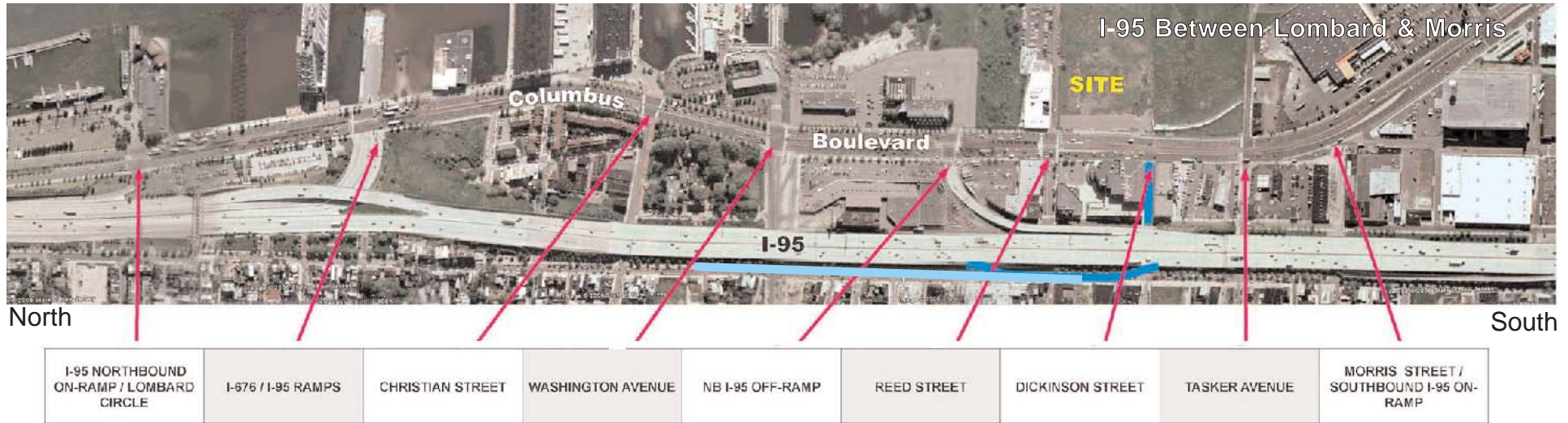

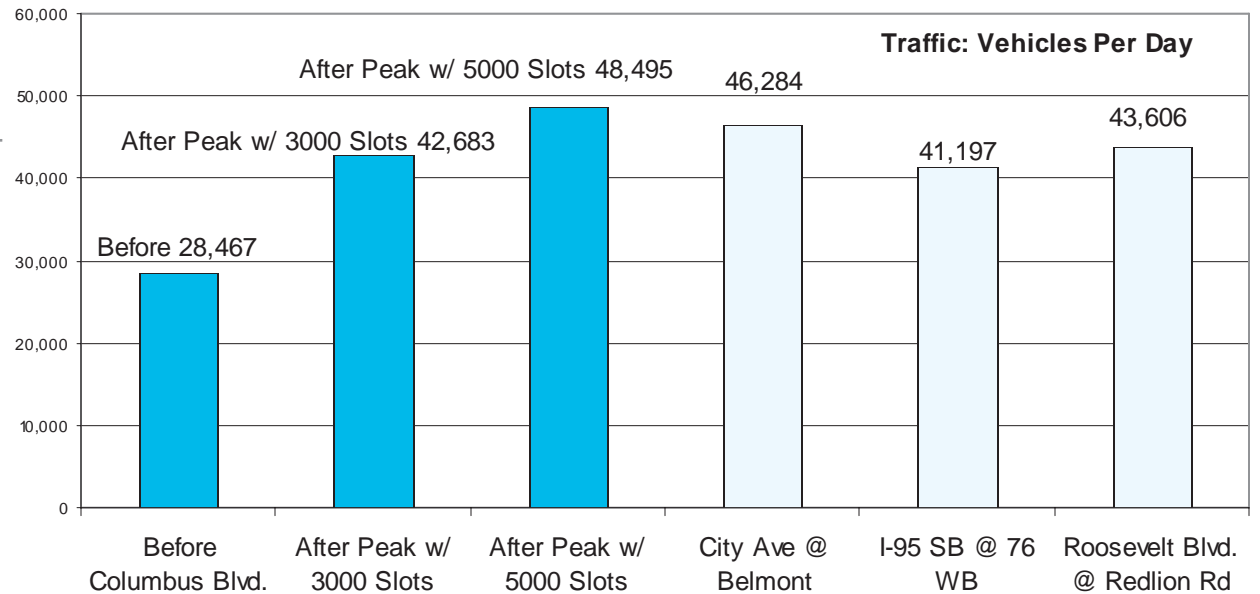
\* Foxwoods spokeswoman Maureen Garrity pointed out that the size of Foxwoods' parcel is given as 16 acres in Foxwoods' press releases. However, city tax records show the site measuring 25 acres. Garrity did not respond to a request for clarification on this point.





Along with several traffic flow modifications (new lanes, signal timing changes, widened lanes) at the indicated intersections along Columbus Blvd., Foxwoods would like to see a new exit ramp (indicated in blue above) built from I-95 SB that would start over Carpenter street and come down at Dickinson. New exit ramps typically take 10 years and cost millions. Foxwoods' traffic study contends, despite the increased traffic, their improvements will actually make traffic run more smoothly on Delaware Ave. afterwards.

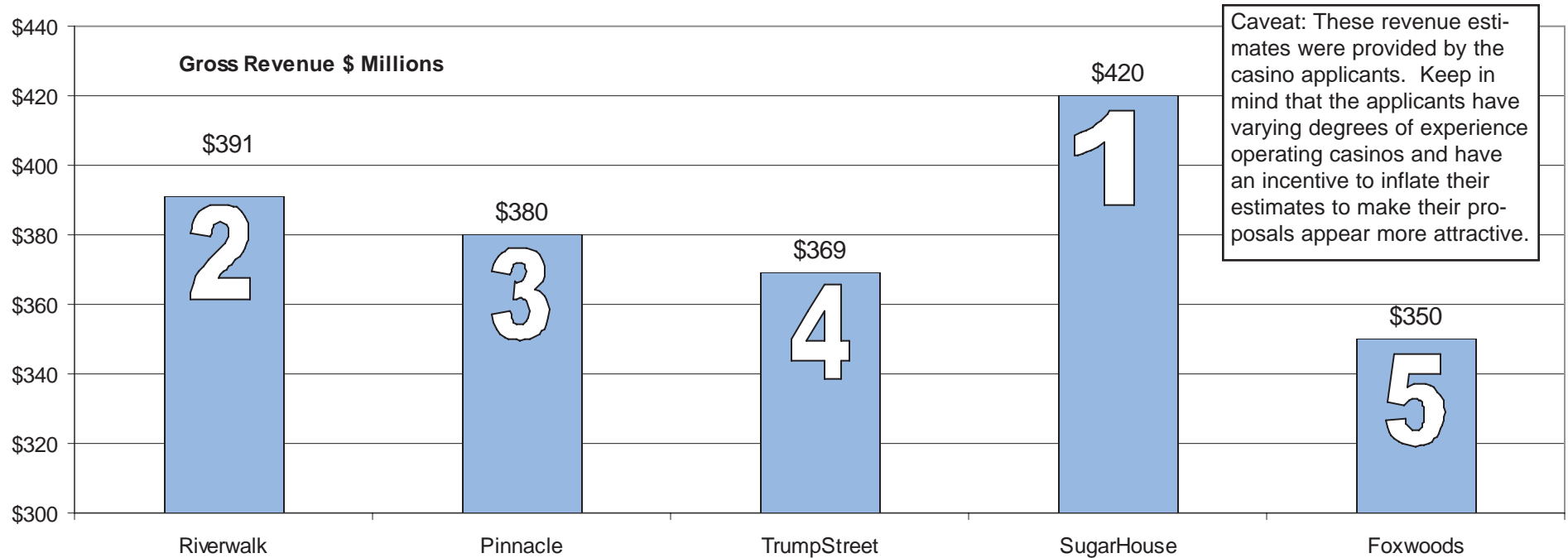

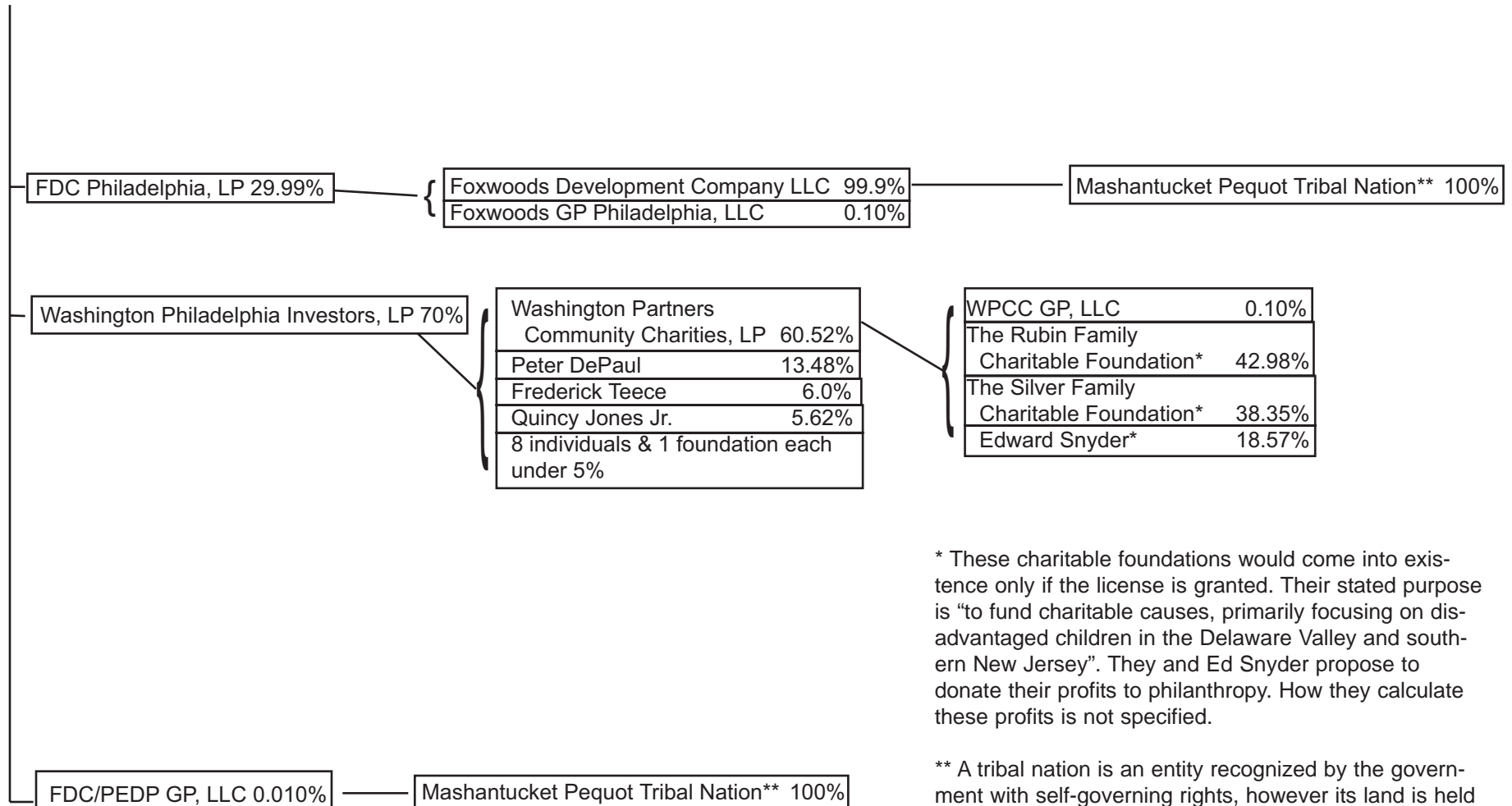

Foxwoods spokeswoman Maureen Garrity said that charitable giving funded by its Philadelphia casino could be as high as \$300 million over ten years, but did not respond to a written request that Foxwoods explain in detail how it arrived at this figure.

\*Spokeswoman Garrity said she disagreed with Hallwatch's conclusion that homes within one mile of a new Foxwoods' casino would decline by a total of \$109 million. She did not respond to a request for a copy of Foxwoods' own, recently completed study of its casino's effect on South Philadelphia home values.

\* These charitable foundations would come into existence only if the license is granted. Their stated purpose is "to fund charitable causes, primarily focusing on disadvantaged children in the Delaware Valley and southern New Jersey". They and Ed Snyder propose to donate their profits to philanthropy. How they calculate these profits is not specified.

\*\* A tribal nation is an entity recognized by the government with self-governing rights, however its land is held in trust by the US and federal law regulates its political and economic rights.
